

How to find West Downs



Travelling by car, Park and Ride and on foot

Visitors travelling by car on the M3 should leave at Junction 11, pass through Badger Farm Road and turn right at the second roundabout to proceed along Romsey Road – West Downs is on the left hand side. The South Winchester Park and Ride is accessible from Junction 11 of the M3. There are Park and Ride bus stops along Romsey Road close to West Downs. Please see the map opposite for the location of public car parks in the city centre and for directions on foot to Romsey Road. West Downs is approximately a 15 minute walk from the city centre.

By train

The West Downs Centre is less than one mile (approximately 15 minutes walk) from the railway station. Leave the railway station by the main exit and turn right into Station Road leading into Upper High Street. Turn right over the bridge and then into Clifton Terrace. Walk along Clifton Terrace until you reach the main road (Romsey Road). Walk up the hill past the prison and the Hillier garden centre – the entrance to the West Downs Centre is on your right.
